

United Church Assistance Program UCAP

The Ecclesiastical Department offers a service to its ministers, practitioners, home office and field staffs and to members of our Boards and Core Councils and all family members in these groups. The division under which it operates is known as United Church Assistance Program (UCAP).

UCAP offers assessment, referral and counseling to those requiring assistance in recovery from alcohol and other drug related problems. It also provides similar support for all emotional illnesses and for those addictions referred to as process addictions --- addictions such as gambling, sexual addiction, etc.

Since UCAP's inception in 1991 there have been 244 clients guided through their various challenges. The program enjoys a success rate of 73.9%+, or about 12% higher than comparable Employee Assistance Programs.
